2024 BUDGET MESSAGE

SERVICES PROVIDED

The District provides wastewater collection service to approximately 100 residences in its service area, which is located in the City of Sheridan, County of Arapahoe, Colorado.

The District prepares its budget on the modified accrual basis of accounting.

REVENUE

Property Taxes

In 2024 the District will receive a small amount of revenue from property taxes. For 2024 the District certified a property tax mill levy of 0.563 mills to raise approximately \$3,937. The bulk of the District's revenues for 2024 will be from accumulated reserves.

DISTRICT'S PURPOSE

Until August of 2021, the District had been inactive and without a Board of Directors for several years. On August 23, 2021 three Board members were appointed to the District's Board of Directors by the Sheridan City Council. The District's purpose at this point in time is to dissolve and to transfer its assets and service responsibilities to the Valley Sanitation District. Dissolution of the District will be contingent upon the District being able to upgrade its sanitary sewer collection system to meet the standards and specifications of the Valley Sanitation District. To obtain funding for this purpose it will most likely be necessary for the District voters to approve the incurrence of general obligation debt.

It is anticipated that all of the District's funds will be expended in connection with the District's dissolution efforts and the rehabilitation of certain sanitary sewer lines. Any monies remaining at the time the District is dissolved will be transferred to the Valley Sanitation District, which has agreed to continue the District's service responsibilities and to include all of the District's territory subject to Sheridan Sanitation District voter approval.

LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENTS

The District has not entered into, and therefore the budget does not provide, for any lease purchase agreements.

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2016 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE SHERIDAN SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 1, CITY OF SHERIDAN, COUNTY OF ARAPAHOE, COLORADO FOR THE 2023 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Sheridan Sanitation District No. 1, adopted the District's annual budget in accordance with the Colorado Local Government Law; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$3,937; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for debt service purposes from general property tax revenue is \$0;

WHEREAS, in order to provide relief by a temporary reduction in property taxes pursuant to Sections 39-1-111.5 and 29-1-306 C.R.S., the Board has determined that a temporary mill levy rate reduction as set forth in the budget should be approved and certified to the County in accordance with the provisions of Section 39-1-111.5, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 valuation for assessment for the Sheridan Sanitation District No. 1, as certified by the Arapahoe County Assessor, is \$6,997,922.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Sheridan Sanitation District No. 1, City of Sheridan, County of Arapahoe, Colorado as follows:

- Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating, maintenance and contingency expenses of the Sheridan Sanitation District No. 1 during the 2023 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.563 mills (after a temporary mill levy reduction of 0.171 mills) upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Sheridan Sanitation District No. 1 to raise \$3,939 in revenue.
- Section 2. There are no debt service payments for the 2023 budget year for the District and therefore no debt service mill levy is raised.

Section 3. That the Treasurer, Legal Counsel and/or President of the District is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, the mill levies for the District as hereinabove determined and set, or as adjusted, if necessary, upon receipt of the final certification of valuation from the county assessor, including any mill levy rate reduction, in order to comply with any applicable revenue and other budgetary limits.
